Let's talk about check-in time.



From the time you bring a pup or a rescue into your home, you should develop a habit that will make every type of training easier; looking for direction and affirmation that she's doing the right thing.

When out walking your dog, it is free to follow his nose. You should encourage lots of sniffing on walks. The only requirements should be a loose leash and that he checks in from time to time. The dog should momentarily connect with the human with eye contract.

Communication is a two-way street and it develops communication with your dog. As an example, if a strange, unruly dog is approaching, he may look to you for instruction. If his ball rolls where he can't get it, he

will look to you for assistance.

We should be reinforcing eye contact every chance we get. This does not mean you pop a treat in his mouth every time, it means using a positive word such as "yes".

You should start in your home in a low distracted area, receiving a glance and use treats. When you fee he is giving you direction, move to the yard. Alternate in and out of your house, and pay attention at your door as you leave and come in, as he will learn to stay calm instead of darting in and out.

There are times when your dog will be around very up-scale distractions, but if you use baby steps to keep him focused on you, this will be a big step in keeping him calm in a dangerous situation. Even though you may have an older dog, working on this practice can give you some assurance and help you through some bad situations.

I feel working our dogs in class with a large group is positive training to keep our dogs in FOCUS.
