When we think of intelligence in dogs, every animal is smart in its own way, and comparisons are inherently unfair. The average dog's intelligence is roughly equivalent to a 2-2.5 year old human - can understand roughly 165 sounds, signs and signals.

There is a huge spectrum of intelligence from breed to breed. Dogs with strong adaptive intelligence may be easier to house train. Those with instinctive intelligence master the tasks it was bred to perform. Retrievers retrieve, herding dogs herd and toy dogs are good at reading humans.

The environment a dog lives in, the dog's background, how people interact with it - all these things matter. Getting our dogs socialized early and in a puppy class, is so important to give the dog an emotional beginning in living with their human companion.

Dogs gather information from our emotional state. They can gauge whether a person is feeling positive or negative emotions by our expressions. They are masters of body language too.

When working with dogs on canine intelligence skills in designing training programs, it can reveal an individual dog's strengths and weakness.

Dogs with high intelligence tests related to discipline tend to be much better for people with disabilities, they need to have a lot of self-control.

Just the opposite trait - lack of self control - predicts success among bomb-sniffing dogs, they need an incredibly high search drive.

The human-canine bond is an old one - but the field of canine cognition is young. We have a lot to learn before we understand the minds of our best cross-species friends.
