

As winter deepens its grip, many of us find ourselves navigating dark pre-dawn and post-dusk walks. Our canine friends still need the exercise, stimulation and training that walks provide.

The darkness presents certain challenges and potential dangers, including wildlife and uneven footing.



Fortunately, a variety of products exist to help make both people and pets more visible and therefore safer when walking in the dark.

There are LED lights attached to the dog's collar and leashes that can run with flashing illumination.

Reflective collars and high visibility vests which are placed on dogs during hunting season to help prevent tragic misidentification accidents.

People can also be protected with high visibility safety vests and head lamps and LED beanies.

There are some holiday cautions you should be aware of to keep your dog safe and healthy:

Foods dangerous to dogs are grapes, raisins, onions, garlic, chocolate, macadamia nuts, avocados, yeast dough and moldy or spoiled foods. Fatty leftovers can cause life-threatening pancreatitis.

Many common household items: mothballs, potpourri oils, fabric softener sheets, dishwashing detergents and batteries.

Automotive products such as gasoline, oil and antifreeze should be stored in areas inaccessible to your pet.

If using a live Christmas tree and water and you use additives to keep it fresh, can be harmful to dogs.
