The most Popular Breed by Decade

Dogs are one of the most popular in North America with 900 million in the U.S. 2023.

1910-1919 - Boston Terrier (Mary's Gunner) It originated in 1800's as a cross between a white English Terrier and an English Bulldog. Introduced to the AKC in 1893 and remains the only one to date that has reached the #1 of most popular breeds in the Country.

1920-1929 Boston Terrier & German Shepherd (Sue's Willowbie) It became popular because of the Hollywood canine Rin Tin Tin.

1930 - 1939 - The Boston Terrier regained its popularity as the Great Depression ravished the smaller breeds.

1940 - 1949 - Cocker Spaniel (Sara's Toby) known for its long flowing ears and cheerful temperament. Both English and American Cockers recognized.

1950 - 1959 - Beagle (Elaine's Willow, Charlie, Ollie) With the debut of Charles Schultz comic strip named Snoopy the Beagle skyrocketed to the top. Bred as hunting dogs, they make energetic and loyal pets.

1960 - 1969 - Poodle (Lori's Reuben) Fashion and art became more popular which brought back the larger breeds. This dog was bred as a waterdog with a coat that doesn't shed.

1970 - 1979 - Poodle This time the miniature & toy were added to the Standard.

1980 - 1989 - Cocker Spaniel back again.

1990 - 1999 - Cocker Spaniel - Labrador Retriever, in 1992 The Cocker spaniel was edged by the Labrador Retriever and has held its lead as the most popular breed throughout the 2000's and 2001's and is holding strong in the 2020's (Amy's Chewy & Winnie; Bechtel's HAN; Phil's Tripp; Hepner's Drake & Mabel.

Whether or not you made the list all that really matters is that he's your happy & healthy companion.
