In Obedience Training we want our dogs to be happy. It is more than a 15 minute a-day training session. It is a 24 hr-a-day relationship. Everything we do with our dogs affects their attitude and behavior from the way we let them out in the morning to where they sleep at night.

Don't merely take your dog for a walk, but interact with

playing games with the dog. The source of fun is playing with you. The greatest motivator is the handler's voice. Food and toys are merely an extension or extra perk in training. If you don't get the dog tuned into you and and excited and happy about being with you, the toys and food will do nothing for you.

Talking to our dogs in a normal tone of voice makes them happy and attentive with a wagging tail. Higher pitches makes them excited, so watch your dog as you speak and see their reaction. Are they motivated or bored?

The bottom line for producing a happy, motivated dog is (1) the dog must have a thorough understanding of what is expected, and (2) there must be a reciprocal trust and respect between dog and handler.

Praise is an important element of any behavior training. You will need to find the level that works best fort your dog, so that neither overstimulation (loses focus) and under appreciated (loses interest). You must not overcorrect and must anticipate the dog's behavior so you can build a positive foundation and a strong bond.

Training should be in bits and pieces rather than huge leaps - a factor that often leads to impatience and frustration.
