As we begin a New Year, let's look into a Crystal Ball and see what dogs are telling us. We often do things that please us but dogs may "tell US" something different.



First, look at your dog and into his eyes. His expression can tell you a lot how he is feeling. They seem to be watching us all the time to let us know what is on their mind. Ex. Time to eat (Patty knows when it is 3:00 pm), need to potty, sound of car keys tells them they are going somewhere (Marina)

We want our dogs to be happy and even though we get busy with our own activities, they are looking for things that can stimulate them which is important.

Everyone should walk their dog, and let them do some sniffing. Dogs like to have a companion dog to walk with

and that can be a good time to work on leash training as well. You can vary where you walk. Work some training into your walk and mix it up to keep it mentally stimulating (Parkour).

With winter months and being isolated indoors, dogs can have fun playing hide and seek, you can hide treats around the house for "go find". Maybe rearranging a few pieces of furniture to do some weaving and obedience work.

Thera are stimulation toys, snuffle mats, food dispensing toys that can be filled with the dog's meal. You can use a muffin pan with treats and place a tennis ball on top of each cup for the dog to use his nose or paw to release the treat.

The New Year is a good time to evaluate what we can do better to engage our dogs with us and make for a better relationship with our Companion.
