When people come to a training class with high expectations, they wonder, "How long will it take to train my dog". They want a quick fix for leash walking, sit, down, come, etc.

In working with dogs for many years, I make sure to tell them, "I do not train your dog, I teach you how to train your dog."

Now the next question is, "how do you want to train your dog?"

Looking back, it was prong collars, no food, yanking on leashes, yelling at dogs. Yes, your dog would respond to all of this, but how would the dog feel? I have seen fearful dogs

after this type of training and it will last a lifetime.

Now how long does it take to train a dog? It depends. Keep in mind that dogs learn more quickly with practice and patience.

Another factor to be aware of is different breeds have different types of skills and intelligence. Your dog is always sitting, watching and thinking even if you are not aware of it.

Using high value treats at the beginning of training, such as cheese, chicken and hot dogs, will get a better response than normal treats. After your dog is accomplishing an exercise, it is time to wean them off, but remember, they always need that occasional positive reinforcement to keep the dog happy and responsive.

Training is all about the dog learning to focus on you and coming to classes each week, I see the progress of all our dogs, even with the distraction of squirrels, motorcycles. Occasional train whistles, etc.

Being able to be at the Marina for classes helps to give our dogs real life experiences and I appreciate the Shikellamy State Park Marina for allowing us to have our training there.

Socializing and keeping our dogs happy is what STDTC is all about. I am around of all of you.
