Since many of our dogs have experienced playing in our local dog parks (Selinsgrove, Northumberland, and Lewisburg) there are certain rules of dog park etiquette that should be followed.

Not all dogs are good candidates for dog park play. A dog park is not the appropriate place for dogs that have serious behavior problems in relation to other dogs. There is no doubt that different breeds of dogs, and even certain dogs, play differently. Some dogs have not learned socialization from an early age and may be aggressive toward other dogs.

You should consider and evaluate your dog before taking him to a dog park:

Your dog should be friendly and outgoing, without being overbearing or bullying.

If your dog is fearful, aggressive or reactive, it is not appropriate for a dog park.

Basic good manners should be a prerequisite. No body slamming, mouth-

ing, or jumping on humans in the dog park.

Try to have your dog trained to basic commands of "come", "sit", and "leave it" so you can get control of him if necessary.

Only healthy dogs should visit the park. Even though your dog may be up-to-date on vaccines, other dogs visiting may not.

Small children should be watched carefully or not brought into the park

for fear of injury while the dogs are running.

Before taking your dog into the park observe park play for several minutes to be sure there are not dogs present that would be an inappropriate partner for your dog.

Remove your dog's leash before entering and any corrective collar he

may be wearing.

Always carry a baggie for cleanup after your dog.

Supervise your dog's play. Be prepared to interrupt inappropriate play. This is not the time to spend on your iPhone.

Dog parks can be a wonderful place for you to socialize and exercise your dog, but by following some basic rules of etiquette it can make it a safe and fun experience for all.
