We should now be focusing on when they are doing something right - on walks are they walking without pulling, having some control over squirrels, waiting as we throw that ball for a retrieve? Yes, we must reward when they are doing something GOOD!

Compared to all the "official" training you learn - behaviors such as sit, down, come, stay - the moments when your dog is just being quietly GOOD seem like - nothing.

The moments when he receives a reinforcer for exhibiting a behavior you like, such as a sweet pat, a kind word, or a tiny treat, will let him think, "Ah!" Everything's always nice when I do this thing!

With our covid restrictions we are able to view actions our dogs exhibit and we can train behaviors we see in their daily lives. It is obvious to you how you want your dog to act. Reinforcing the behaviors you'd prefer to see your dog display gives him a bright trail to follow.

All of us have different rules and we need to allow our dogs to make more of its own choices for a behaviorally, healthier companion and a better relationship between the two of you.

Yes, have rules, but it should be up to you, it's your house, you get to make the rules.

**Pets Need your Support - Proposed Xylitol Legislation:** 

Xylitol is an artificial sweetener used in many everyday products: sugar free gum, vitamins, cough drops, peanut better, and more. It is highly poisonous to pets, especially dogs and is frequently not listed on the ingredient label. Xylitol impacts your pet's sugar levels, leads to liver failure and life threatening if not treated right away.

To address this issue and better inform pet owners of the risk, Representatives David Schweikert (R-Ariz.) and Greg Stanton (D-AZ-9) introduced the Paws Off Act of 2021 (H.R. 5261). This bipartisan legislation would simply require food containing Xylitol to include warning label specifying its toxic effects to dogs and other pets.

They need our help to ensure this important legislation passes for all pets. Please call or email your Representatives and ask them to support the Paws Off Act of 2021 (H.R. 5261)
