

Some have been through a "Puppy Stage" with our dogs. Some have adopted dogs that have come to training as Adult dogs. This information can relate to both:



There is a period after puppy called "Adolescence". It is a transitional state of physical and psychological development which can be from 6 months to 2 years of age, depending on the size of the dog. We don't let them make their own decisions, we control every aspect of their lives and keep them dependent on us. "They just don't know that!" Their wishes often conflict with ours.

You have done everything right early on by bringing them to a "Puppy Class" where it has been properly socialized and trained. When it reaches this "Adolescent State" it should not be hard for you to get back on track as you can relate to continuing your attention to training. Bringing your dog to a Beginner Class helps manage this state. Your dog has not forgotten everything you taught him/her in a puppy class. He/she has just put things on hold while attending to the priority of finding his/her place in the real world.

This is the time to make training fun, using lots of happy praise. Play, cheer on you dog, act silly. Use food dispensing toys, hide and seek, puzzle toys, hide treats around your house. Play can be a time to use some obedience skills like having your dog to wait before throwing the ball.

Exercise is so important and this means walking your dog daily, not just putting him out in your yard.

When we allow our dogs to make choices and not having a tight control over their lives, you will make it through adolescence with flying colors and your relationship with your dog will be stronger
